Episode 69 – Interview with Dr. Allison: COVID-19 and Canadian Oral Healthcare Professions September 23, 2022

Dr. Paul Allison,¹ Faculty of Dental Medicine & Oral Health Sciences, McGill University
Dr. Allison is a dentist with specialist training in oral and maxillofacial surgery and dental public health and research training in epidemiology. He has been Director of the Quebec-based Oral and Bone Health Research Network during 2005-08 and served two mandates as Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry at McGill during 2008-18. He was President of the Association of Canadian Faculties of Dentistry during 2015-19 and of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences during 2019-20 and was on the Governing Council of the Canadian Institutes of Health Research during 2018-21.

Dr. Allison's research interests include social determinants of oral health and dental care, access to dental care, and related policies. He is currently a member of the Lancet Commission on Global Oral Health;² a project leader with the World Health Organization (WHO) developing global indicators of oral health for the WHO oral health strategy³ currently under development; as well as leader of a national Canadian research team working with Statistics Canada on the oral health element of cycle 7 of the Canadian Health Measures Survey.⁴
