What made you want to become a dental hygienist?

What type of practice setting do you hope to work in?

We got partnered with children in the organization and I realized I really enjoy helping make the dental experience a fun one. The typical step by step appointment plan doesn't work all the time for these clients, and I enjoyed that opportunity to find what worked best for them. I have been toying with the idea of opening my own mobile clinic, targeting people who are unable to be in a dental environment due to fear or overstimulation or physical ability. I want to build trust with those clients, ensuring they are comfortable and well taken care of.

How will you celebrate your graduation?

I'll finish classes in mid-August and our graduation is likely in October. Personally, I plan on taking a breath. I've been in post-secondary school for 8 years straight out of high school, so I would love to take a break from studying and working. Maybe I'll take a little trip somewhere in Canada! I also have some concerts and events lined up, so I am excited to just relax for a moment before beginning my career.
