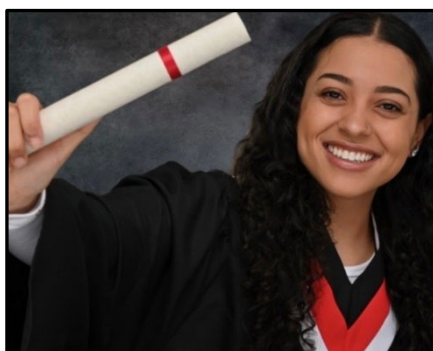


ODHA STUDENT AMBASSADOR PROFILE – ELLA SMALL
